

Roza Thun, MEP, European People's Party

Spokesman of Students Committee of Solidarność and a co-worker of Komitet Obrony Robotników in 1977- 1980

Chairman of Shuman Foundation in Poland in 1992- 2005. During the campaign prior to the Poland accession into EU structures, Roza Thun initiated and organised several debates, meetings and events which has promoted advantages of Poland's membership in EU structures.

Head of the European Commission Representation to Poland (2005 - 2009). Since 2009 European Parliament election, member of the Civic Platform (Platforma Obywatelska).

In European Parliament, she works in the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection and in the Committee on Culture and Education. Roza Thun is also a member of the Delegation for relations with Israel, Delegation to the "Parliamentary Assembly - Union for the Mediterranean" and Delegation for relations with the Palestinian Legislative Council.

In November 2011 Roza Thun has been named a 'Man of the Year' by a 'The Parliament Magazine' in category of Internal Market and Consumer Policy. In 2012 she was also elected Man of the Year of Malopolska Region by Gazeta Krakowska and also has been considered as one of the most influential women in Malopolska region.

In 2011 and 2013 she was granted a MEP Award for most active Members of European Parliament in the field of Internal Market and Consumers Policy. In 2014 Roza Thun has been also given a MEP Award in the field of Internet policy making.

In 2014 Roza Thun successfully ran for re-election to European Parliament from Świętokrzyski and Malopolska district, earning fifth place in the country in terms of the number of votes cast. In 2015 she was elected chairperson of the Working Group to Digital Single Market in the European Parliament.
